

**A BYLAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF BLUCHER, #343 TO
ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH CARGILL LIMITED.**

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Blucher, #343, in the Province of Saskatchewan, hereby enacts as follows:

WHEREAS Cargill Limited has constructed a canola crushing plant to be located in the Rural Municipality of Blucher;

AND WHEREAS the infrastructure relating to the establishment of the canola crushing plant will support further industrial and commercial development and it is likely that such development will occur in ensuing years;

AND WHEREAS it is desirable that the Rural Municipality of Blucher have a role in regulating and conducting the disposition of waste water arising from the canola crushing plant and further industrial and commercial development in this area;

AND WHEREAS Council considers it advisable to grant aid to Cargill Limited;

NOW THEREFORE be it resolved that pursuant to the powers and authority granted to Council, including without limiting the generality of the foregoing, Sections 226, 227, 228, 237 and 252 of the Rural Municipally Act, 1989, and the powers granted Council pursuant to The Public Utility Easements Act, Council hereby enacts as follows:

1. The Reeve and Administrator are hereby authorized to enter into agreement with Cargill Limited, under the seal of the Municipality, for the Installation of a public waste water treatment and processing facility in the form appended to this bylaw, and marked as Schedule "A";
2. The Reeve and Administrator are hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with Cargill Limited, under the seal of the Municipality for the operation of the public waste water treatment and processing facility in the form appended to this bylaw, and marked as Schedule "B";
3. The Reeve and Administrator are hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with Cargill Limited, under the seal of the Municipality, for whereby the Municipality shall be granted certain rights, including an easement over certain Lands owned by Cargill, for a public waste water treatment and processing facility in the form appended to this bylaw, and marked as Schedule "C";
4. For the purposes of this bylaw, the Schedule and Appendices referred to in the attached agreements need not be attached at this time, but may be added at the time of execution.
